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SUMMARY

It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would extend the property tax break for low income housing owned by a nonprofit. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Extends the sunset date for the property tax exemption for nonprofit corporation low income housing.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
