SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs the LRO to study the state financial system. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the state financial system. Directs the Legislative Revenue Officer to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue not later than December 1, 2026.

- 2 Relating to state finance.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Legislative Revenue Officer shall study the state financial system. The Legislative Revenue Officer shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue no later than December 1, 2026.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
