

# Senate Bill 156

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans, Emergency Management, Federal and World Affairs)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act requires LPRO to study world affairs and write and submit a report about it. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.2).

Requires the Legislative Policy and Research Officer to study international affairs. Directs the officer to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to veterans, emergency management and federal and world affairs not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunset on January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to international affairs.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Policy and Research Officer shall study international affairs.**  
5 **The officer shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include**  
6 **recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**  
7 **lated to veterans, emergency management and federal and world affairs no later than Sep-**  
8 **tember 15, 2026.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
