

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 27

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “workforce” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

2 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

3 “**SECTION 1.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
4 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
5 General Fund, the amount of \$20,000,000, for the purpose of paying the nonfederal share of
6 the Oregon Essential Workforce Health Care Program established under ORS 735.520.

7 “**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
8 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
9 General Fund, the amount of \$2,500,000, for the purpose of paying the nonfederal share of the
10 Oregon CareWorks Supplemental Payment Program.

11 “**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
12 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
13 General Fund, the amount of \$2,500,000, for the purpose of providing reimbursements to
14 hospitals participating in a labor-management training trust, as provided in ORS 676.479, as
15 amended by section 2, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 283).

16 “**SECTION 4.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
17 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
18 General Fund, the amount of \$9,500,000, for the purpose of providing an incentive payment
19 to federally qualified health centers, as provided in ORS 676.479, as amended by section 2,
20 chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 283).

21 “**SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
22 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
23 General Fund, the amount of \$15,000,000, for the purpose of providing reimbursements to
24 support clinical education at hospitals under ORS 676.476.

25 “**SECTION 6.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
26 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out
27 of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,000,000, for the purpose of providing reimbursements
28 to support clinical education in long term care facilities and residential care facilities under
29 ORS 676.476, as amended by section 1, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill
30 283).

31 “**SECTION 7.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
32 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
33 on its passage.”.
