Senate Bill 33

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs DHS to study how it provides services to children and families. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Requires the Department of Human Services to study how it delivers services to children and families. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services not later than September 15, 2026.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Human Services shall study how it delivers services to

5 children and families. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS

6 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the

7 Legislative Assembly related to human services no later than September 15, 2026.

8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
