## Senate Bill 338

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act tells the Gov. to tell a U.S. official that a marine sanctuary in this state will not be accepted unless the legislature signs off on it. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.5). Requires the Governor to certify to the United States Secretary of Commerce that the desig-

Requires the Governor to certify to the United States Secretary of Commerce that the designation of a national marine sanctuary located within the seaward boundary of Oregon is unacceptable unless the Legislative Assembly confirms the designation.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to legislative confirmation of national marine sanctuaries.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> If the United States Secretary of Commerce issues notice of designation with

5 respect to a proposed national marine sanctuary that is to be located partially or entirely

6 within the seaward boundary of this state, the Governor must certify to the secretary that

7 the designation is unacceptable, except upon confirmation by the Legislative Assembly that

8 all terms of the national marine sanctuary are acceptable. Legislative confirmation as re-

9 quired by this section shall be by joint resolution of the Legislative Assembly that is in ses-

10 sion at the time notice of the designation is made or during the regular or special session

11 of the Legislative Assembly next following the designation.
