## Senate Bill 452

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DAS for Marion-Polk Food Share. (Flesch Readability Score: 78.2).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Marion-Polk Food Share, Inc., for a capital expansion project.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July

6 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,000 for distribution to Marion-Polk

7 Food Share, Inc., a domestic nonprofit corporation, for a capital expansion project.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 10 July 1, 2025.
