Senate Bill 483

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells LPRO to look at ways that the LA can have oversight over administrative rules and make a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.6).

Requires the Legislative Policy and Research Director to study methods for legislative oversight of administrative rules. Directs the director to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to general government not later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to administrative rules. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Legislative Policy and Research Director shall study methods for legislative oversight of administrative rules. The director shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to general government no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
