Senate Bill 543

Sponsored by Senator SOLLMAN (at the request of Centro Cultural de Washington County) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells ODOT to translate student driver education and instructor guides into Spanish. ODOT must put the materials on its website. ODOT must also offer printed copies but may charge a fee to cover the costs of printing. ODOT must update the guides every three years. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.7).

Directs the Department of Transportation to translate student driver education curriculum and student driver instructor curriculum into the Spanish language and post the materials on the department's website. Directs the department to provide printed copies and authorizes the department to charge a fee to cover the printing costs.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to traffic safety education.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall translate the student driver education curriculum and the student driver education instructor curriculum into the Spanish language and provide links to the curriculum on the department's website.
 - (2) The department shall also make printed copies available for purchase and may charge a fee to cover the printing costs.
 - (3) The translated materials must be updated at least once every three years.
