**SUMMARY**

Digest: The Act approves agency fees. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.4).  
Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by the State Department of Agriculture.  
Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**
