

# Senate Bill 5516

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an agency budget. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.8).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.

Limits biennial expenditures from lottery moneys allocated to the department for the State School Fund.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the department for the State School Fund.

Specifies amounts the department may spend for certain purposes from the State School Fund.

Transfers moneys from the State School Fund to the Local Option Equalization Grants Account.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the state financial administration of the Department of Education; and declaring an  
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
6 **ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**  
7 **General Fund, the amount of \$9,860,133,424 for the State School Fund.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
9 **\$608,613,172 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**  
10 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**  
11 **nomics Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
13 **\$16,646,271 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**  
14 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys distributed from the Education Stability Fund to**  
15 **the Department of Education for the State School Fund.**

16 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
17 **\$44,157,823 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**  
18 **payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues,**  
19 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds de-**  
20 **scribed in section 5 of this 2025 Act, collected or received by the department for the State**  
21 **School Fund.**

22 **SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
23 **\$829,892,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**  
24 **payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues,**

1 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or  
2 received by the department for the State School Fund from the Fund for Student Success  
3 established under ORS 327.001.

4 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the biennium beginning July  
5 1, 2025, the Department of Education:

6 (1) May spend up to \$968,000 from the State School Fund for the contract described in  
7 ORS 329.488.

8 (2) May spend up to \$1,600,000 from the State School Fund for purposes related to Oregon  
9 Digital Learning.

10 (3) May spend up to \$3,000,000 from the State School Fund for the School Safety and  
11 Emergency Management program.

12 (4) May transfer up to \$5,365,632 from the State School Fund to the Oregon Military De-  
13 partment for the Oregon Youth Challenge Program.

14 **SECTION 7.** The amount of \$4,000,000 is transferred from the State School Fund to the  
15 Local Option Equalization Grants Account created in ORS 327.339.

16 **SECTION 8.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
17 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect  
18 July 1, 2025.

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
