

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5517

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Oregon Department of Emergency Manage-
3 ment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following
4 amounts, for the following purposes:

- 5 (1) Administration..... \$ 21,883,931
- 6 (2) Preparedness and Response.. \$ 5,326,001
- 7 (3) Mitigation and Recovery..... \$ 300,833
- 8 (4) Debt Service..... \$ 5,765,853

9 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
10 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment
11 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
12 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of
13 Emergency Management, for the following purposes:

- 14 (1) Administration..... \$ 455,173
- 15 (2) 9-1-1 Emergency Program..... \$ 149,545,258
- 16 (3) Preparedness and Response.. \$ 7,811,957
- 17 (4) Statewide Interoperability
18 Program..... \$ 3,869,857
- 19 (5) Mitigation and Recovery..... \$ 24,525,466

20 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
21 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment
22 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Emer-
23 gency Management, for the following purposes:

- 24 (1) Administration..... \$ 669,894
- 25 (2) Preparedness and Response.. \$ 63,025,681
- 26 (3) Mitigation and Recovery..... \$ 1,034,862,740

27 “**SECTION 4.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
29 July 1, 2025.”
