Senate Bill 560

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act exempts tips from personal income tax. (Flesch Readability Score: 71.8). Creates an Oregon personal income tax subtraction for tips received by the taxpayer during the x year.

Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2026, and before January 1, 2032. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to an income tax subtraction for tips received; and prescribing an effective date. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 316. 4 SECTION 2. There shall be subtracted from federal taxable income any amount of tips 5 properly reported as wages on the taxpayer's federal income tax return. 6 7 SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies to amounts received in tax years beginning 8 on or after January 1, 2026, and before January 1, 2032. SECTION 4. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 9 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 10 11
