Senate Bill 592

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would have DLCD study the formation of a new city in the Stafford triangle area of Clackamas County. The Act would require a report to be turned in next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Requires the Department of Land Conservation and Development to study the formation of a new city in the Stafford triangle area in Clackamas County and submit a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to land use no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Stafford triangle area in Clackamas County.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Land Conservation and Development shall conduct a study of the formation of a new city in the Stafford triangle area in Clackamas County. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to land use no later than September 15, 2026.
- 8 The report may include recommendations for legislation.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
