SUMMARY

It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Stops the review of social studies standards by the State Board of Education. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.4).

Repeals the directive to the State Board of Education to review social studies standards. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to social studies standards; repealing section 1, chapter 406, Oregon Laws 2021; and de-3 claring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1, chapter 406, Oregon Laws 2021, is repealed.

6 SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect

8 on its passage.
