

Senate Bill 716

Sponsored by Senator GORSEK (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells OHA to make rules about registering urgent care centers and creates some standards. Tells some insurers to cover cost of care at registered urgent care centers at a set rate. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.5).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules for registering urgent care centers and specifies requirements.

Requires coverage of services provided by registered urgent care centers by health insurance that reimburses medical costs, plans offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board, health maintenance organizations and multiple employer welfare arrangements and establishes requirements for rates of reimbursement.

Takes effect on the 91st day after adjournment sine die.

REGISTERING OF URGENT CARE CENTERS

8 **SECTION 1.** (1) **As used in this section, "urgent care center" means a medical clinic that**
9 **accepts walk-in patients and is equipped to provide care for illnesses or injuries that require**
10 **prompt attention but typically are not so serious as to require emergency department ser-**
11 **vices.**

12 (2) **The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt by rule criteria for registering an urgent**
13 **care center in this state. The rules must ensure that a registered urgent care center:**

14 (a) **Is certified or accredited by a nationally recognized organization or other entity ap-**
15 **proved by the authority under ORS 441.062;**

16 (b) **Has expanded hours of operation;**

17 (c) **Is equipped to diagnose and treat a broad spectrum of illnesses or injuries that are**
18 **not life-threatening or so serious as to require emergency department services;**

19 (d) **Has on-site radiology, laboratory services and emergency equipment;**

20 (e) **Accepts unscheduled, walk-in patients during all hours of operation;**

21 (f) **Conforms to the accessibility standards established by the Americans with Disabilities**
22 **Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.); and**

23 (g) **Is equipped to respond to an emergency situation, including enhanced security meas-**
24 **ures in the event of a public safety incident.**

25 (3) **An urgent care center registered in this state must provide the following services:**

26 (a) **Medical examination, diagnosis and treatment and follow-up medical examinations,**

1 **procedures and treatments; and**

2 **(b) Same-day ambulatory health care, including on-demand and scheduled medical,**

6 **(B) Injured workers with workers' compensation coverage;**

7 **(C) Individuals covered by commercial insurance, Medicare, medical assistance or**
 8 **TRICARE; and**

9 **(D) Individuals who wish to pay for their own care.**

10 **(4) The authority shall prescribe by rule the fee for registering an urgent care center,**
 11 **which may not exceed the authority's costs related to administering the registration re-**
 12 **quirements and must be based on the size and complexity of the urgent care center.**

13 **(5) The authority may revoke an urgent care center's registration for failing to meet the**
 14 **requirements established in this section or the rules adopted by the authority to carry out**
 15 **this section.**

20 **SECTION 3. (1) A policy or certificate of health insurance issued in this state that re-**
 21 **imburses the cost of medical care must reimburse the cost of services provided by an urgent**
 22 **care center registered pursuant to section 1 of this 2025 Act in an amount 20 percent higher**
 23 **than the reimbursement paid for the same services when provided by a medical clinic that**
 24 **is associated with a licensed hospital or an unregistered urgent care center.**

25 **(2) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.**

26 **(3) As used in this section, "urgent care center" has the meaning given that term in**

OPERATIVE DATE

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SECTION 12. (1) Sections 1 and 3 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 243.144, 243.877, 750.055 and 750.333 by sections 4 to 10 of this 2025 Act become operative on January 1, 2026.

(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall take all steps prior to the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that are necessary to carry out the provisions of section 1 of this 2025 Act on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 13. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
