

# Senate Bill 803

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Tina Kotek for Oregon Military Department)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Allows efforts to make the SSLI program more open to members of the National Guard. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Requires the Adjutant General to allow efforts to make the state-sponsored life insurance program available to members of the Oregon National Guard.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the state-sponsored life insurance program for Oregon National Guard members.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "state-sponsored life insurance program" means**  
5 **the group life insurance program allowed under 37 U.S.C. 707 and exclusively offered to all**  
6 **members of the Oregon National Guard through the Oregon National Guard Association.**

7 **(2) The Adjutant General shall, at the discretion of the Adjutant General:**

8 **(a) Allow efforts to make the state-sponsored life insurance program available to all**  
9 **members of the Oregon National Guard;**

10 **(b) Provide opportunities for members of the Oregon National Guard to purchase pro-**  
11 **ducts from the state-sponsored life insurance program; and**

12 **(c) Allow representatives from the state-sponsored life insurance program to provide in-**  
13 **formation through briefings on the state-sponsored life insurance program to members of**  
14 **the Oregon National Guard during active and inactive duty training periods.**
