- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "health" insert "; and declaring an emergency".

- 6 ties; and
- Whereas community mental health programs are required by statute to
- 8 provide specific services to individuals experiencing a behavioral health cri-
- 9 sis, individuals charged with a crime and found unable to aid and assist in
- their own defense and individuals subject to civil commitment proceedings;
- 11 and
- "Whereas the Oregon Health Authority conducted, pursuant to section 1,
- chapter 80, Oregon Laws 2024, a cost study to determine the funding required
- 14 for each community mental health program to provide those services; and
- "Whereas the cost study, which was completed with the assistance of an
- actuary, determined that there is a gap between the funding that is currently
- 17 available and the funding that is needed for community mental health pro-
- 18 grams to provide the services required by statute; now, therefore,".
- Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
- 21 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount 1 of \$64,800,000, for distribution to community mental health programs 2 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 161.315 to 161.351, 3 161.355 to 161.371, 161.385 to 161.395, 161.505 to 161.585, 426.005 to 426.390, 4 426.510 to 426.680, 426.701, 426.702, 430.627, 430.628, 430.629 and 430.630. 5 "SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate 6

preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.".
