**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1086**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon insert
2 “creating new provisions;”.

3 Delete lines 25 through 29 and insert:

4 “(e) Develop a proposal to guide the State Apprenticeship and Training
5 Council in establishing an apprenticeship program for building inspectors
6 that meets the requirements set forth in ORS 660.002 to 660.210. The pro-
7 posal, at a minimum, must address for building inspector apprentices:

8 “(A) Training requirements and apprenticeship standards that comply
9 with the requirements of ORS 660.126;

10 “(B) The contents of apprenticeship agreements in accordance with ORS
11 660.060;

12 “(C) Pay rates in accordance with ORS 660.142;

13 “(D) Employment protections in accordance with ORS 660.143;

14 “(E) Which state agency will form and administer a state joint committee
15 for the purpose of promoting and coordinating the goals of an apprenticeship
16 program in building inspection;

17 “(F) Which state agency will become a training agent for the apprentice-
18 ship program, or approve training agents, including municipalities that in-
19 tend to establish local apprenticeship programs, to the extent that the
20 training agents comply with requirements the proposal addresses in subpar-
21 agraphs (A) to (D) of this paragraph; and

1 “(G) Which state agency shall issue, or authorize a municipality to issue,
2 appropriate certifications for completion of an apprenticeship as a building
3 inspector.”.

4 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 13.

5 After line 24, insert:

6 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part
7 of ORS 660.002 to 660.210.**

8 **“SECTION 3. (1) The State Apprenticeship and Training Council
9 shall establish an apprenticeship program for building inspectors in
10 accordance with a proposal that the Director of the Department of
11 Consumer and Business Services provides to the council under ORS
12 455.720 (1)(e). The apprenticeship program must be suited to meet the
13 statewide need for properly trained building inspectors and reflect the
14 standards, contents of apprenticeship agreements, pay rates and em-
15 ployment protections the director recommends in the proposal.**

16 **“(2) The council may, with the consent and cooperation of another
17 state agency or a municipality, as defined in ORS 455.010, designate the
18 other state agency or municipality to serve as a training agent or ap-
19 prove training agents for building inspector apprentices and to issue
20 or authorize the issuance of appropriate certifications for completion
21 of an apprenticeship as a building inspector.”.**

22 In line 25, delete “2” and insert “4”.

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
