**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2566**

1 On page 4 of the printed bill, line 33, after the period insert “Systems,
2 technologies, equipment or measures associated with a distribution system
3 may be eligible to be considered as part of a stand-alone energy resilience
4 project. Rules adopted under this paragraph may not allow, as part of a
5 stand-alone energy resilience project, the construction, installation or repair
6 of an energy generation system that is not a renewable energy system.”.

7 On page 5, delete lines 21 through 24 and insert:

8 “(B) 50 percent or more for grants to be awarded for the following:

9 “(i) Planning or developing community renewable energy projects that
10 primarily serve one or more qualifying communities; or

11 “(ii) Developing stand-alone energy resilience projects that primarily
12 serve one or more qualifying communities.

13 “(b) For each opportunity announcement for developing a stand-alone en-
14 ergy resilience project that the department issues, the department shall al-
15 locate, out of the moneys made available in the calendar interval for all
16 grants under the Community Renewable and Resilient Energy Grant Pro-
17 gram, 20 percent for grants for developing stand-alone energy resilience
18 projects. The department may reallocate moneys that were initially allocated
19 but not awarded under an opportunity announcement for developing a
20 stand-alone energy resilience project that the department issues.”.

21 In line 30, delete “(b)” and insert “(c)”.
