**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3348**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 8, delete “419B.005,”.

2 Delete lines 12 through 30 and delete pages 2 to 6 and insert:

3 “**NOTE:** Sections 1 and 2 were deleted by amendment. Subsequent
4 sections were not renumbered.”.

5 On page 22, delete lines 29 through 45.

6 On page 23, delete line 1 through 13 and insert:

7 “**SECTION 21.** ORS 25.260 is amended to read:

8 “25.260. [(1) *As used in this section, ‘child support program’ means:*]

9 “[*(a) The program described in ORS 180.345;*]

10 “[*(b) The Administrator of the Division of Child Support of the Department*
11 *of Justice;*]

12 “[*(c) A district attorney; and*]

13 “[*(d) The administrator’s or district attorney’s authorized representative.*]

14 “[~~(2)~~] (1) Unless otherwise authorized by law, child support records, in-
15 cluding data contained in the **Oregon** Child Support Program’s automated
16 system, are confidential and may be disclosed or used only as necessary for
17 the administration of the program.

18 “[~~(3)~~] (2) In administering the Child Support Program, the program may:

19 “(a) In accordance with rules adopted under subsection [~~(7)~~] (6) of this
20 section, report abuse as defined in ORS 419B.005 if the abuse is discovered
21 while providing program services.

1 “(b) Extract and [receive] **exchange** information from other databases as
2 necessary to carry out the program’s responsibilities under state and federal
3 law.

4 “[4] (3) The [child support] program may compare and share information
5 with public and private entities as necessary to [perform] **carry out** the
6 program’s responsibilities under state and federal law.

7 “[5] (4) The [child support] program may exchange information with
8 state agencies administering the following programs as necessary for the
9 **Oregon** Child Support Program and the state agencies to perform their re-
10 sponsibilities under state and federal law:

11 “(a) Programs funded under Title IV, XIX or XXI of the Social Security
12 Act; and

13 “(b) The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program under ORS 411.806
14 to 411.845.

15 “[6] (5) In addition to any penalty to which an individual may be subject
16 under ORS 25.990, an employee of the Department of Justice, of a district
17 attorney or of the Department of Human Services who discloses or uses the
18 contents of any records in violation of subsection [(2)] (1) of this section is
19 subject to discipline, up to and including dismissal from employment.

20 “[7] (6) The Department of Justice shall adopt rules consistent with
21 federal regulations governing confidentiality of **Oregon** Child Support Pro-
22 gram information.”.

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
