**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 844**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 4, after “438.990,” insert “475A.380,
2 475A.483,”.

3 On page 2, line 1, after the period insert “The report must include the
4 most recently available relevant data.”.

5 In line 3, after “report” insert “required under ORS 432.141 (3) in 2027.”.

6 In line 4, after “Notwithstanding” delete the rest of the line and insert
7 “ORS 432.141 (3), the report required under ORS 432.141 (3) is not required
8 to be submitted in 2026.”.

9 Delete lines 34 and 35 and insert:

10 “(3) If the authority issues a notice of intent to deny a license or permit,
11 a notice of intent to impose a disciplinary sanction or a notice of intent to
12 deny training program course approval, the authority:”.

13 In line 44, before “training” insert “provider of a”.

14 On page 3, delete lines 2 through 6 and insert:

15 “(4) If the authority issues a notice of intent to deny a license or permit,
16 a notice of intent to impose a disciplinary sanction or a notice of intent to
17 deny a training program course approval, the applicant, permittee, provider
18 of a training program or licensee that is the subject of the notice may re-
19 quest, and the authority shall disclose to the applicant, permittee, provider
20 of a training program or licensee all information obtained by the authority
21 in the investigation of the allegations in the notice except:”.

1 Delete lines 15 through 18 and insert:

2 “(a) A notice of intent issued by the authority to deny a license or permit,
3 to impose a disciplinary sanction against an applicant, permittee, provider
4 of a training program or licensee or to deny training program course ap-
5 proval;

6 “(b) A final order that results from a notice described in paragraph (a)
7 of this subsection;”.

8 After line 38, insert:

9 “**SECTION 7.** ORS 475A.380 is amended to read:

10 “475A.380. [*Minimum standards of education and training for psilocybin*
11 *service facilitators; rules.*] (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt by
12 rule minimum standards of education and training requirements for
13 psilocybin service facilitators.

14 “(2) The authority shall approve **training program** courses for psilocybin
15 service facilitators. To obtain approval of a **training program** course, the
16 provider of a **training program** course must submit an outline of instruction
17 to the authority. The outline must include the approved **training program**
18 courses, total hours of instruction, hours of lectures in theory and the hours
19 of instruction in application of practical skills.

20 “**SECTION 8.** ORS 475A.483 is amended to read:

21 “475A.483. [*Issuing, renewing permits; fees; rules.*] (1) The Oregon Health
22 Authority shall issue permits to qualified applicants to perform work de-
23 scribed in ORS 475A.480. The authority shall adopt rules establishing:

24 “(a) The qualifications for performing work described in ORS 475A.480;

25 “(b) The term of a permit issued under this section;

26 “(c) Procedures for applying for and renewing a permit issued under this
27 section; and

28 “(d) Reasonable application, issuance and renewal fees for a permit issued
29 under this section.

30 “(2)(a) The authority may require an individual applying for a permit

1 under this section to successfully complete a **training program** course,
2 made available by or through the authority, through which the individual
3 receives training on:

4 “(A) Checking identification;

5 “(B) Detecting intoxication;

6 “(C) Handling psilocybin products;

7 “(D) If applicable, the manufacturing of psilocybin products;

8 “(E) The content of ORS 475A.210 to 475A.722 and rules adopted under
9 ORS 475A.210 to 475A.722; or

10 “(F) Any matter deemed necessary by the authority to protect the public
11 health and safety.

12 “(b) The authority or other provider of a **training program** course may
13 charge a reasonable fee for the **training program** course.

14 “(c) The authority may not require an individual to successfully complete
15 a **training program** course more than once, except that:

16 “(A) As part of a final order suspending a permit issued under this sec-
17 tion, the authority may require a permit holder to successfully complete the
18 **training program** course as a condition of lifting the suspension; and

19 “(B) As part of a final order revoking a permit issued under this section,
20 the authority shall require an individual to successfully complete the
21 **training program** course prior to applying for a new permit.

22 “(3) The authority shall conduct a criminal records check under ORS
23 181A.195 on an individual applying for a permit under this section.

24 “(4) Subject to the applicable provisions of ORS chapter 183, the authority
25 may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a permit if the individual
26 who is applying for or who holds the permit:

27 “(a) Is convicted of a felony or is convicted of an offense under ORS
28 475A.210 to 475A.722, except that the authority may not consider a conviction
29 for an offense under ORS 475A.210 to 475A.722 if the date of the conviction
30 is two or more years before the date of the application or renewal;

1 “(b) Violates any provision of ORS 475A.210 to 475A.722 or any rule
2 adopted under ORS 475A.210 to 475A.722; or

3 “(c) Makes a false statement to the authority.

4 “(5) A permit issued under this section is a personal privilege and permits
5 work described under ORS 475A.480 only for the individual who holds the
6 permit.”.

7 In line 39, delete “7” and insert “9”.

8 On page 4, line 17, delete “8” and insert “10”.

9 On page 5, delete lines 10 through 13 and insert:

10 **“SECTION 11. Sections 5 and 6 of this 2025 Act and the amendments**
11 **to ORS 475A.380, 475A.483, 475A.586 and 676.177 by sections 7 to 10 of**
12 **this 2025 Act apply to information obtained by the Oregon Health Au-**
13 **thority or health professional regulatory board on or after the effec-**
14 **tive date of this 2025 Act.”.**

15 In line 17, delete “10” and insert “12”.

17 In line 24, delete “12” and insert “14”.
