**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3824**

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 11.

2 In line 12, delete “(5)” and insert “(4)”.

3 Delete lines 15 through 19 and insert:

4 “(5) The Oregon Board of Physical Therapy may seek an injunction  
5 against a person who engages in conduct in violation of subsection (1) or (3)  
6 of this section in a court of competent jurisdiction. An injunction may be  
7 issued upon demonstration by the board that the person is likely to continue  
8 the conduct or has caused irreparable harm as a result of the conduct.”.

9 On page 14, delete lines 30 through 35 and insert:

10 “(6) If the board receives a complaint that a person is engaged in conduct  
11 that violates ORS 688.020 (1) or (3), or on its own initiative begins an in-  
12 vestigation, the board shall investigate to the extent necessary to determine  
13 whether the person is engaged in the alleged conduct and shall inform the  
14 person of the investigation and reason for the investigation. The board may  
15 refer the matter to the Attorney General or to the appropriate district at-  
16 torney.”.
