**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 5544**

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS**  
3 **291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State**  
4 **Board of Chiropractic Examiners and approved by the Oregon Depart-**  
5 **ment of Administrative Services, are approved:**

6 **“(1) For chiropractic physician applicants and licensees:**

7 **“(a) Initial application and background check fee: \$495**

8 **“(b) Initial application and background check fee for reciprocity**  
9 **candidates: \$495**

10 **“(c) Initial license fee: \$234**

11 **“(d) Active annual registration fee: \$663**

12 **“(e) Senior active annual registration fee: \$491.40**

13 **“(f) Inactive annual registration fee: \$351**

14 **“(g) Delinquent fee for late renewal: \$150 per week**

15 **“(2) For chiropractic assistant applicants and certificate holders:**

16 **“(a) Initial application, certification and background check fee: \$175**

17 **“(b) Annual renewal fee: \$117**

18 **“(3) Criminal background check fee for applicants, chiropractic**  
19 **physicians and chiropractic assistants: \$45**

20 **“(4) For civil penalty citations, if issued:**

21 **“(a) Failing to notify the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners**

1 **within 30 days of changes to email, business and mailing addresses: \$50**

2 **“(b) Failing to pay fines or fees owed to the State Board of**  
3 **Chiropractic Examiners: \$50 per month of nonpayment**

4 **“(c) Failing to comply with continuing education requirements for**  
5 **chiropractic assistants: \$15 per credit not completed**

6 **“(d) Failing to notify the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners**  
7 **within 10 days that a licensee is convicted of a misdemeanor or felony**  
8 **or arrested for a felony crime: \$125 per week**

9 **“(e) Failing to notify the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners of**  
10 **designated records custodian: \$500**

11 **“SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
12 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
13 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.**
