4 **Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General**  
5 **Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

 3 **icare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery,**

 5 **Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and**  
 6 **federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the**  
 7 **Department of Human Services, for the following purposes:**

17 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures**  
18 **by the Department of Human Services for federal supplemental nutri-**  
19 **tion assistance payments are not limited.**

20 **“SECTION 5. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
21 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
22 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.**
