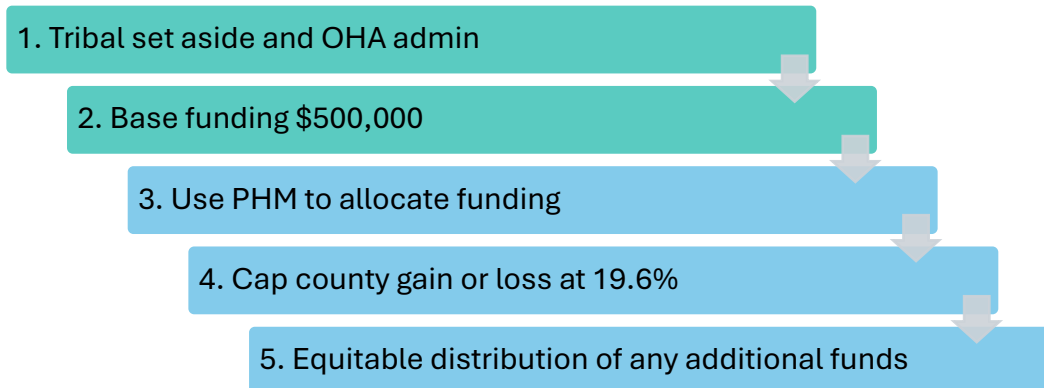


SB 610 Formula Summary

Changes under
SB 610

1. Subtract the tribal set aside (\$30.4M) and Oregon Health Authority's administrative costs (\$30M) from the total funds available.
2. Provide base funding of \$2M (or \$500k for each county per year).
3. Apply the Public Health Modernization (PHM) formula to allocate the remaining funds.
4. Cap individual county gains and losses at 19.6% relative to the amount of funds they received in the 2022-2025 cycle. Any additional funds beyond a county's cap are then redistributed.
5. Any future funds received beyond the initial allocation would first be given to counties receiving fewer funds than the previous funding cycle.

These additional funds would be distributed evenly until each county's total allocated funds are equal to the funds they received in the previous funding cycle.

Once no counties are receiving fewer total funds than allocated in the previous funding cycle, additional funds would be distributed based on the PHM formula's indicator allocations.



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
