Dear Chair Golden, Vice-Chair Nash, and members of the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Wildfire,

I urge you to support SB 77 and SB78. I am greatly concerned about the loss of farm and timberland and its conversion to other uses such as expensive homes, hotels, entertainment venues, commercial businesses, etc. in Oregon. Timber and farmland are edged out more and more every year with the rapid and continued population growth that is happening. The problem is becoming significant.

Farms and timberlands feed our people and supply our timber.
