My name is Cierra Buer and I am an Oregon resident asking you to support HB 3362.

Each year in Oregon, there are over 7,000 wildlife-vehicle collisions with large animals. On average, four people die and over 500 people are seriously injured. The cost of these collisions on Oregon roadways is likely more than \$100 million each year. The animals in these situations also suffer. It is a lose-lose situation.

There is a solution. Wildlife crossing structures are a proven, popular, and cost-effective technique to improve public safety and restore habitat connectivity.

Oregon needs a permanent source of funding to implement state programs and projects to improve motorist and wildlife safety. Permanent funding would improve roadway safety, remove barriers to wildlife and help Oregon capture federal funding.

Please protect both our wildlife and our communities by supporting HB 3362.
