My name is Ryder. I live in House District 33, and I support HB 3362 for three reasons.

Firstly, car driving and pollution from car tires damages our air quality, water quality, our transportation infrastructure (requiring more maintenance), and public health (through car accidents, air pollution, etc.). Taxing cars to clean up the damage they cause is just a smart policy.

Secondly, a 4% tax on tires is about \$4-8 per tire. If someone is concerned about buying a car due to its price, an extra \$32 will not be the reason of concern

Thirdly, I don't own a car and my travel through my city and across the state is slower and more dangerous than by car. I want to see more investments into alternatives to driving so that people don't have to pay this tax because they don't need to own cars.
