

2025 PGA Golf Pool Info

Hello golfers! Last year we had 79 teams, paid 6 places and the (tied) winners, Frances Tanaka and Dan Malone collected \$514 apiece. Hopefully, you'll spread the word so we can get more participants and pay more places. Feel free to forward this to any and all of your golfing group(s). I'll be sending out more information around Thanksgiving with tournament schedule, player rankings (again), etc. Entries are due by Monday, January 1st, 2025.

The cost is \$20 per entry.

You pick **one** A player, **two** B players, **two** C players and **one** D player to represent your team. The D players also include **any** player not in the Top 110. See Player Rankings attached.

Fill out the entry form (completely) and send it back to me with your **check**.

Points are awarded to the top 6 scores in each tournament, not the top 6 'places'. If there's a tie for first, the winner will get top points and the 'losers' of the playoff will get 2nd place points. I've seen as many as 24 players earn points due to ties.

For a typical tournament, points are awarded as follows:

1st – 30
2nd – 25
3rd – 20
4th – 15
5th – 10
6th – 5

For 'enhanced' events ('*' on the schedule) and Canadian Open, Scottish Open and FedEx Playoff tournaments, points are:

1st – 40
2nd – 35
3rd – 30
4th – 25
5th – 20
6th – 15

For Major tournaments (and The Players) ('**' on the schedule), points are:

1st – 50
2nd – 45
3rd – 40
4th – 35
5th – 30
6th – 25

Tournament schedule notes:

There are a few weekends where two events are held (i.e., British Open weekend). In that case, I'll track points for both tournaments.

Payouts:

If we get 20 or fewer participants, payouts will be as follows:

1st – %50
2nd – %25
3rd – %15
4th – %10

If we get between 21 and 50 participants, payouts will be as follows:

1st – %40
2nd – %30
3rd – %15
4th – %10
5th - %5

If we get more than 50 participants, payouts will be as follows:

1st – %40
2nd – %25
3rd – %15
4th – %10
5th - %6
6th - %4

If we get more than 80 participants, payouts will be as follows:

1st – %35
2nd – %20
3rd – %15
4th – %11
5th - %9
6th - %6
7th - %4
