Re: Support SB 1076, Breeder License Legislation

The following organizations fully support SB 1076, directing the Department of Agriculture (ODA) to create a breeder licensure and standards program for dogs, cats, small mammals, and small birds.

Oregon's Animal Rescue Entities (AREs) have been licensed and inspected through the ODA for the last four years. However, the program was only funded for the first biennium, and it was anticipated that for future years, the annual ARE license fees, which come from largely nonprofit organizations, would fully fund this state program's operational and staffing costs.

There is a clear and ongoing shelter capacity crisis in Oregon. According to Shelter Animals Count, in 2024, 65,764 cats and dogs entered Oregon's shelter and rescue system. It is vital to find a secure and equitable financial solution for this program so that increasing licensing fees do not overburden atcapacity Oregon's rescues and shelters, which serve as a public resource in both urban and rural communities and provide lifesaving services across the state.

Conversely, Oregon breeders are not licensed, regulated, or inspected. It is time for Oregon breeders to be held accountable to high standards and responsibility for animal care and welfare, disease prevention, and oversight.

In the face of the shelter capacity crisis in Oregon and the unsustainable strain on our animal rescue entities across our state, please support SB 1076. Thank you for your consideration.
