I know of many churches who want to use their land to build housing, but it is difficult to navigate all the preplanning, permitting, and working with the surrounding community – all of these things must happen before development can actually begin. With small grants of predevelopment funds, faith communities and other nonprofit organizations could fulfill dreams of housing our neighbors; it would be a major turning point in our communities – we could finally turn the tide on the crisis of affordable housing.
