Yes to SB 703/HB 2788, Pathways to Protection and Citizenship

Dear Chair Prozanski Vice-Chair Thatcher and Members of the Committee,

My name is Nacia Castañeda, I live in Washington County and I support SB 703/HB 2788, Pathways to Protection and Citizenship. This bill came before you as HB 4085 in 2024, and passed this Committee unanimously. HB 2788/SB 703 is a bill that will save and strengthen families, improve outcomes in other DHS programs, bolster our workforce and strengthen Oregon's general fund.

Oregonians identified to receive immigration legal assistance include:

- Dreamers
- Those Who Served as Interpreters for U.S. Armed Forces in Iraq and Afghanistan
- Those Eligible Under Federal Law to Change Status or Obtain Lawful Permanent Resident Status
- Citizenship Applicants

285,700 immigrant Oregonians are workers in Oregon's labor force. Including 64% of those in crop production and thousands of them are currently eligible under federal law for an immigration status. That is thousands of Oregonians who, but for a few hundred dollars, are living in fear, out of mainstream employment and unable to support their families.

120,000 of Oregon immigrants are eligible for naturalization. This bill's one-time support of Oregonians to offset these legal costs will stabilize our workforce.
