There is no financial impact statement, and only a vague reference to damage being addressed by federal or state employees, and considering the budget situation of both entities, relief is more likely to be unavailable than available.

The state of Oregon has a lot of issues, regulated trapping is not one of them. The best, most accurate data for fur bearers comes from the required harvest reports each trapper turns in at the end of the season.
