As a rural healthcare provider in coastal Oregon, eliminating and reducing access burden's to care is critical to caring for our often very sick patients. They often have multiple complex healthcare disorders, have limited transportation or have to travel long distances to attend Physical Therapy sessions. This bill would allow my patients to not have to worry about a needless interruption of care by arbitrary hurdles and limits of prior authorization.
