As a specialized Physical Therapist treating pelvic rehabilitation in an outpatient clinic in Medford, OR, I ask all representatives to support HB 3134. The lost treatment time, excess administrative burden and costs associated with insurance authorizations and insurance company case reviews is inexcusable. Clinically, I spend roughly 20% of my time addressing insurance issues, case reviews (typically with incompetent "professionals" representing Evicore or insurance companies. I have had a 100% approval for the initial PT requests as a specialist in the last 2.5 years; there is no reason to require the initial authorized visits. The only beneficiary is Evicore. Our office staff routinely get told wrong information and spend between 30-60 min. Verifying benefits (often through Evicore and the insurance company). Delayed payments when cases are being reviewed are up to 6 months after treatments are rendered. This will crush many small independent clinics who provide specialty services.
