We support the adoption of HB 3422 and request the House Committee on Climate, Energy, and Environment to move this important measure to eventual passage by the 2025 Oregon Legislature.

Since large scale solar facilities can have a detrimental effect on the limited supply of high value farmland, **HB 3422** adds an alternative analysis to the standards that must be met before the Energy Facilities Siting Council can take an exception to a planning goal for a new solar energy facility.

The time is right for the legislature to pay serious attention to Oregon's farm, range, and forest land and the many resources those lands protect. Please stop the land speculation and conversion of Oregon's limited and precious agricultural and forest land resulting from unintended loopholes in existing land use statutes.
