I am specifically writing to oppose the proposed ban on devices that speed up fire of weapons. United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas held in *National Association for Gun Rights, et al. v. Garland* that Rare Breed FRT-15s and Wide-Open Triggers (WOTs) are not machineguns under the NFA and as such, their possession is not in violation of Federal law. Therefore those devices should not be banned on the state level.

If this ban goes through and is made law then it will be unconstitutional and definitely challenged. This will be a huge waste of resources and tax payers money for the state to incorrectly argue in the courts that these devices should be banned. Stop treating us gun owners like criminals.
