I am writing asking you to support the common sense gun violence prevention measures that have been consolidated into this bill. One of the components is a 72 hour waiting period. We know that people suffering from depression often act impulsively to purchase a gun and then use it shortly after to take their life. Giving people a cooling off period can be a vital way to save people's lives. We have a crisis of suicide in our state. Over 75% of gun deaths in our state are gun suicides. When suicide is attempted by another means it often fails, giving the person a chance to get counseling. Gun suicide often takes the person's life, and they never get the chance to get help.
