Dear House Education Committee,

My name is Tracey Larson and I live in Central Point, OR. I'm a virtual public charter school parent. I'm writing to express my concern about HB 2583. The bill doesn't go far enough. It continues to exclude virtual public charter schools like Cascade Virtual Academy, Insight School of Oregon and Destinations Career Academy from applying for Student Investment Act (SIA) grants. This would impact approximately 2000 students enrolled in these schools. All virtual public charter schools should be eligible to apply for SIA grants. It's unfair to exclude a handful of schools. I hope the committee will adopt the -1 amendment to expand SIA grant eligibility to ALL virtual public charter schools, so all Oregon students can succeed.
