The Oregon Chiropractic Association respectfully opposes HB 3824 for the following concerns.

1. This proposed legislation would allow physical therapy assistants (PTAs) to perform spinal manipulation.

We believe this constitutes a public safety issue (pg. 3, line 40).

2. The chiropractic practice act found at ORS 684.010 that defines “Chiropractic” includes, “...the employment and practice of physiotherapy...” We are concerned this proposed legislation attempts to restrict a doctor of chiropractic from marketing and/or promoting the reality we offer these services to the public.

We ask that you vote no on HB 3824.
