The measure adjourns *sine die* the 2025 first special session of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Latin term *sine die* means "adjournment without a day." The *sine die* resolution is used to connote the final adjournment of a legislative session, without adjourning to a specific time or date. To be valid, the resolution must be adopted in the same form by the Senate and the House of Representatives.

Governor Kotek called for a special session of the Legislative Assembly to address transportation funding. The first special session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly commenced on Friday, August 29, 2025.

House Concurrent Resolution 51 adjourns *sine die* the 2025 first special session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly.
