Dear Representatives

I am writing as a constituent from Mount Angel to respectfully request that you oppose the HB3991 and the 2025 Transportation Tax.

While I recognize the importance of maintaining and improving our state's transportation infrastructure, this proposal imposes undue financial burdens on working families because of a gross misuse of State funding by our leaders.

The plan would significantly increase gas taxes, raise DMV fees, and double the payroll tax. These measures will reduce take-home pay, increase household costs, and disproportionately affect workers who rely on their vehicles for employment, which is a large majority of Oregonians outside of Portland and Eugene city limits.

I urge you to consider the long-term impact on families like mine and vote NO on the 2025 Transportation Tax.
