I supported the much larger transportation package. Oregon desperately needs to invest in transportation. I happily pay a high % of state income tax and would be thrilled to raise my STIF contribution to support more transportation -- it makes the state a much better place to live and supports my money.

Transportation is one of the key pieces of responsibility the state has; it's the infrastructure that gets people from A to B. Failing to fund transportation is absurd when:

- 1. WE ARE IN A CLIMATE CRISIS -- it is absolutely absurd to be conservative about transit funding when vehicle emissions are a major barrier to hitting our state climate goals. Any reduction in emissions is good. It's too late to stop significant warming but not too late to make things better.
- 2. NOT EVERYONE CAN AFFORD A CAR -- gutting transportation funding will further impoverish many of our most vulnerable Oregonians.

I grudgingly support this bill as a stopgap/band-aid, strongly oppose amendments that reduce the funding level, and strongly oppose referring it to ballot or any further delays in its passage.

If lawmakers want to threaten a walkout over it: please make them put their money where their mouth is. We can continue having a debate in this state about quorum reform, but only if the issue is front-and-center for voters.
