I'm a trucker driver hauling fuel with a set of doubles into Washington Idaho and Oregon. I'm an Oregon resident born and raised on the coast. I currently live in Portland.

I oppose this transportation tax.

Last week I tapped out my log book at 70 hours for the week. Working in the heat-14 hour days. Like many weeks most of the year grinding along.

I'm currently outside of Cascade Locks off I 84 writing you.

I cross so many highways and byways across the PNW. I see a lot, I travel across many different terrains. I support ODOTS road- maintence crew, I do not support wasteful spending.

I go over the big mountain passes daily with a set of doubles hauling 105,500 pounds of fuel. I rely on ODOT to keep the roads clear. However taxing me and other Oregonians into oblivion is NOT the answer.

I'm tired.

I'm tired of working 14 hour days- 6 days a week without overtime and the government taxing my paycheck to death- I'm tired.

This new tax and fee hike will take more money out of my pocket. I am regulated so much by the government as it is. To renew my CDL it will be \$570 dollars. I have a hazmat certificate, twic card, background checks, physicals. DOT has inspected me three times in the last nine months.

Seventy hours is the max I can work in a week by law. You're taxing me to death making me realize this job just isn't worth it.

To the Republicans and Democrats please meet in the middle. Find a solution to ODOTS budget without raising taxes or fees. It's getting to the point where working hard isn't worth working anymore.
