SB 797

Modifies laws regulating public accountancy professionals.

## **Public Hearing**

SB 433

Permits the owner of a self-service storage facility to advertise or publish a notice of sale of personal property that is subject to a lien once on a publicly accessible website that regularly advertises or offers personal property for auction or sale.

SB 583

Establishes the State Public Bank Task Force.

588 SB

Provides that post-traumatic stress disorder suffered by a police officer or firefighter is an injury or disease sustained in the actual performance of duties for purposes of benefits under the Public Employees Retirement System in certain circumstances.

SB902

Requires the Public Employees Retirement Board to study age qualifications for retirement.

946 \*\* SB

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Authorizes the payment out of the Workers' Benefit Fund of the expenses of the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries in carrying out the commissioner's statutory duties.
