PSYCHIATRIC SECURITY REVIEW BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Psychiatric Security Review Board subject to Senate confirmation.¹

New Appointees

Robert McKelvey of Milwaukie

DesBrisay: August 1, 2025 – June 30, 2029
McKelvey: July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2029

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of 10 members, including a five-member panel with experience service adults, and a five-member panel with experience serving juveniles, which entail

- a psychiatrist in the criminal justice system (**MCKELVEY**);
- a licensed psychologist in the criminal justice system (KENNEY);
- a person with substantial parole and probation experience (KERNS);
- a lawyer with substantial criminal trial practice experience (**DESBRISAY**);
- a certified, or eligible to be certified, child psychiatrist (NEWMAN);
- a licensed child psychologist (VACANT);
- a person with juvenile parole and probation experience (CASEBIER);
- a lawyer with substantial juvenile law experience (CHILDS); and
- two members of the general public (BOYD, DUKE).

The board may not include a district attorney, deputy district attorney, or public defender. The psychiatrists and psychologists must not otherwise employed on a full-

time basis by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) or a community mental health program.

Members serve four-year terms, are eligible for reappointment, and may be removed by the Governor for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office. Each panel selects its chair to serve for a one-year term. A majority of the voting members of a panel constitutes a quorum. Each panel must meet at least twice every month, unless the chair determines that there is not sufficient business to warrant a meeting.

Duties⁴

A criminal defendant who is found guilty except for insanity may be placed under the jurisdiction of the board. The board ensures persons under its jurisdiction receive the necessary services and support to reduce the risk of future dangerous behavior using recognized principles of risk assessment, victims' interests, and person-centered care.

The board must

- adjudicate the discharge, conditional release, or commitment modification of individuals placed in its jurisdiction;
- provide notice of hearings and orders, conditional release, discharge, or escape to specified parties and afford those parties an opportunity to be heard;
- maintain medical, social, and criminal histories of all committed persons; and
- consult with OHA on the certification of psychiatrists and licensed psychologists for the evaluation of a defendant on the issue of insanity.
