

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 807

Relating to the Oregon National Guard

SB 807 allows the Adjutant General of the Oregon Military Department to pay a bonus to a member of the Oregon National Guard who reenlists or extends their period of service for at least three years.

Under the measure, the Military Department would establish a Retention Bonus Program to offer eligible members of the Oregon Army National Guard who reenlist or extend their period of service a one-time bonus of \$5,000. At a funding level of \$2.5 million General Fund, the program would provide funding for an estimated 500 eligible service member bonuses.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 807 be amended by the –2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
