After nearly 30 days in the literal cold, we've received a tentative agreement from Providence that guarantees nearly none of the that.

We have banded together to support each other - assisting our coworkers by providing child care, food, and financial support. This does not surprise me. We need your help. We know what it means to serve our community. Please help us get back to work with a contract that allows us to do so in a way that will keep Portland a healthy place.
