Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I am writing to express my strong opposition to HB 3057, a bill that further abridges the right to keep and bear arms.

HB 3057 imposes unreasonable requirements on gun owners, necessitating a class that is largely unavailable, followed by a costly and lengthy permit process. Even after completing this arduous process, gun owners will face the possibility of having to restart the entire process upon visiting a gun store.

Additionally, the bill criminalizes the possession of ammunition magazines over 10 rounds unless they were obtained before December 2022, a requirement that is virtually impossible to prove. Furthermore, even legally possessed magazines cannot be taken outside one's home, severely restricting their utility.

This bill not only violates constitutional rights but also represents a waste of taxpayer money, as it is very likely to be overridden by the US Supreme Court.

I urge you to consider the detrimental impact HB 3057 will have on law-abiding gun owners and to vote against this bill.
